

Autumn Term (i) Overview - 2017-2018 - Class 2

This project has a history focus and teaches pupils about the significance of the Romans, who they were, where they came from and their impact on the Celt population of Wales and Britain. At the heart of this project the pupils learn how to write narrative stories with an historical setting and develop additional skills in persuasion and letter writing.

Learn about the historical events associated with the Roman invasion of Britain and Wales and their settlement in these places;

Learn about the culture, religion, buildings and way of life in Roman Britain, and how the settlement affected the Celtic people.

Develop skills and techniques of effective story writing in a historical context. Learn how to include historical detail for accuracy.

Develop the story of Boudicca, told from the perspective of a Roman or Celt that explores feelings and ideas about invasion and settlement.

Place significant events and people on a Roman timeline. Develop date cards using ICT, with images and a brief description of significant events or people.

Research Roman eating habits of the rich and poor.

Explore the role of Roman artists and craftsmen. Make drawings and notes in sketchbooks and learning logs.

Explore the Roman religion. Identify the names of Roman Gods and write character profiles of a chosen Roman God.

Develop understanding of a range of aspects of Roman lifestyle. Research stations could include: the settlement of Romans and impact on towns, the development of roads, costume and home life, Roman Emperors, soldiers and the Roman army and significant people including Julius Caesar.

Identify on maps and globes where the Romans originated from and their routes of travel and initial settlements.

Explore the role of a gladiator in Roman times. Consider the lifestyle of a gladiator.

Mae'r prosiect hwn yn canolbwyntio ar hanes ac yn dysgu disgyblion am bwysigrwydd y Rhufeiniaid, pwy oedden nhw, o ble y daethon nhw a'u heffaith ar boblogaeth Geltaidd Cymru a Phrydain. Wrth wraidd y prosiect hwn mae disgyblion yn dysgu sut i ysgrifennu storiâu naratif â sefyllfa hanesyddol ac yn datblygu sgiliau ychwanegol yn perswadio ac ysgrifennu llythyron.

Dysgu am y digwyddiadau hanesyddol sy'n gysylltiedig â goresgyniad Prydain a Chymru gan y Rhufeiniaid a'u haneddiadau yn y manau hyn.

Dysgu am ddiwylliant, crefydd, adeiladau a ffordd o fyw yn y Brydain Rhufeinig, a sut yr effeithiodd yr anheddiad ar y bobl Geltaidd.

Datblygu sgiliau a thechnegau ysgrifennu stori effeithiol mewn cyd-destun hanesyddol. Dysgu sut i gynnwys manylion hanesyddol er mwyn cywirdeb. Datblygu stori Buddug, wedi'i hadrodd o safbwynt Rhufeiniwr neu Gelt sy'n archwilio teimladau a syniadau am oresgyniad ac anheddiad.

Y Rhufeiniaid

Ymchwil i ddatblygu dealltwriaeth o ystod o agweddau o ffordd o fyw Rhufeinig. Gall gorsafoedd ymchwil gynnwys: anheddiad y Rhufeiniaid a'r effaith ar drefi, datblygiad heolydd, gwisg a bywyd cartref, Ymerawdwr Rhufeinig, milwyr a'r fyddin Rufeinig a phobl bwysig gan gynnwys Cesar.

Gosod digwyddiadau a phobl bwysig ar linell amser Rhufeinig. Datblygu cardiau dyddiadau gan ddefnyddio TGCh, gyda delweddau a disgrifiad byr o ddigwyddiadau a phobl bwysig.

Nodi ar fapiau a globau o ble y tarddodd y Rhufeiniaid a'u llwybrau teithio ac aneddiadau cychwynnol.

Ymchwilio i arferion bwyta Rhufeinig y cyfoethog a'r tlawd.

Archwilio rôl artistiaid a chrefftwyr Rhufeinig. Gwneud lluniau a nodiadau mewn llyfrau brasluniau a logiau dysgu.

Archwilio'r grefydd Rufeinig. Nodi enwau'r Duwiau Rhufeinig ac ysgrifennu proffiliau cymeriad o Dduw Rhufeinig.

Archwilio rôl gladiator yn amser y Rhufeiniaid. Ystyried ffordd o fyw gladiator.
