Free School Meals Policy

Aim

To make provision for those pupils eligible for free school meals worth over £350 per child per year

Eligibility

Your child may qualify if you're entitled to receive one or more of the following:

- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- An income-related employment and support allowance
- Assistance from the UK border Agency
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided you are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £16,190
- Universal Credit: If you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get).

If you're receiving Working Tax Credit for four weeks after your employment has finished, your child is still entitled to free school meals during that period. This also applies if you start working fewer than 16 hours per week.

Application

If you meet the criteria, you can apply to the Board of Directors with all supporting documentation and each case will be considered on an individual basis.

If the application is accepted, the school will be informed and a free school meal will be provided (value £2.30 per day).

Provision

Currently, all pupils bring in their own lunch boxes to school. A lunch box will be provided by the school for pupils qualifying for free school meals.
